

CAUTION

WILD PARSNIP

CAN BE FOUND AROUND THE VILLAGE

Poisonous: Yes, do not touch this plant.

Height: 1 to 2 metres.

Leaves: Pinnately compound with 2-5 pairs of opposite, sharply toothed leaflets.

Stems: Completely smooth and reddish/green in colour.

Flowers: Yellow, umbrella shaped, 10-20 cm across. Similar in appearance to dill.

WHAT IF I COME INTO CONTACT WITH WILD PARSNIP?

- Seek immediate shelter (exposure to sap makes human skin hypersensitive to sunlight)
- Thoroughly wash exposed skin with soap and water
- If skin reacts, seek medical attention
