**REVIEW OF:**

Wellfield Report – The County (Cheryl Mason) called about the property on Hwy 201. It has been cleaned up. County would like us to have a look and make sure it is acceptable. Brian Reid will check it out and take some pictures.

Flow Chart/Contingency Plan – Brian Reid looked over the contingency plan examples Dawn MacNeill had sent. It was decided of the examples that Kings Co. has the format we would like to follow. It was discussed to have David McCoubrey from EMO come to a meeting to give guidance on the order of who to call when for the contingency plan.

K-Class Roads – Jeremy Kelland from NSTIR reported through email that there are no K-Class roads in the source water protection area.

Forestry Practices – Waiting for information from Dawn MacNeill on fire suppression practices from DNR. According to DNR this was the last summer the fire towers will be manned. DNR feels there is enough air traffic and general public to notify of a forest fire. Lisa Taylor spoke with Quentin Jackman re: cutting in source water protection area. There is a boundary line issue so cutting has been delayed. Quentin Jackman will let us know before they proceed after the issues have been resolved. There is no timeframe as of yet. He is still willing to talk with the committee. Lisa Taylor will contact Mr. Jackman to see if he is willing/able to come to the December 4<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Next Steps –

- Lisa Taylor to contact Dave McCoubrey from EMO and Quentin Jackman with DNR, to see if they are willing to talk with us at the next meeting.
- Best Practices for Roadways – Lisa Taylor to contact NSTIR to see what they use on the dirt part of Inglisville Rd when snow clearing.
- Survey – Letter has been updated and agreed to send out to every homeowner in the source water protection area that we can find addresses for. A date of December 31<sup>st</sup> will be added to the bottom of the letter to have the responses back by.
