**REVIEW OF:**

Land Use By-Law

- No Progress.

Protected Water Area Discussion

- Draft is coming together; Dawn will add to it as we have more discussions and circulate before the next meeting.
- Aquaculture- will adopt from Davidson Lake
  1. **Agriculture waste setbacks from watercourses. 12(2)** A person must not conduct aquaculture activities of any kind, commercial or domestic, in the Protected water area.
  2. We will be adding “unless written permission is received from the water works operator.”
- Pesticides- will adopt definition from James River (j) and regulations from Lake Major.
  1. Definition- “pesticide” or “pest control product” has the same meaning as set out in clause 2(q) of the *Pesticide Regulations* made under the Act;
  2. **Pest control products and biocide restrictions-**

- 1) Except as provided in subsection (2), no person shall spray or otherwise apply a pest control product or biocide, including but not limited to, an insecticide, herbicide, or fungicide, within the Protected Water Area.
  - 2) Pest control products and biocides which are exempt from subsection (1) include dormant oils, lime Sulphur, insecticidal soap, Bacillus thuringiensis formulations, and other pest control products or biocides which may be approved from time to time for exemption by the water utility operator. (This is changed from Administrator)
  - 3) With the exception of aerial application of Bacillus thuringiensis formulations, no person shall apply a pest control product listed in subsection (2) within the Protected Water Area unless the application is done by ground method and is administered in accordance with the Act and regulations made pursuant thereto. (we would like to add that written permission from the water works operator needs to be obtained)
- Updates on Agriculture- Add North Tyndal #4
    - 4) No person shall apply manure to land in Zone II and Zone III at a rate whereby combined nitrogen of the manure plus all applied fertilizers exceeds the maximum nitrogen level as recommended by the Nova Scotia Department of Agriculture for the crop being produced.

#### Off Highways Vehicle Act

- Jane has tentatively agreed. Melissa will draft a letter for the County.
- Dawn spoke with a solicitor about the OHV to figure out what we need going forward. We need a map outlining the properties to be included. We do have a map and will get it to Dawn.

#### Next Steps –

- OHV- Map & County request.
- Dawn will bring Road & Powerline regulation examples to the next meeting and these will be discussed more in depth.
